General Details

In order to improve road safety in the vicinity of Bonaly Primary School, two pedestrian crossing points are to be constructed on Bonaly Road. These will be in the form of 'table tops', where the road is raised to the level of the footpaths at the crossing points. The road itself will be narrowed at these points, both to improve visibility for pedestrians, and to help constrain vehicle speeds. The first crossing is located immediately to the south of the junction with Bonaly Wester. The other is in the vicinity of the south end of Bonaly Primary School. In addition, bollards will be introduced to the footpath at the frontage of the school to discourage parking, and the junction of Bonaly Road and Bonaly Wester - which is currently in poor condition - will be resurfaced. Please see the attached plan for details.

Road Use and Access During the Works

Due to the restricted width of the roads in question, it will be necessary to close both Bonaly Road and Bonaly Wester to vehicles in order to carry out resurfacing work. This will be done for the minimum possible time, and closures will only occur between the hours of 9:30am and 4:30pm Monday to Friday, with both roads being open outwith these times. Access for emergency vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times. Residents will be notified of the exact days of the closures nearer the time. Street notice signs will display all necessary information.

Minimising Disruption and Noise

To minimise disruption, work will be carried out during the school Summer break, between the hours of 9.30am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday, with exceptions only if strictly required. No overnight working will be permitted. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and noise, but unfortunately some will be unavoidable. Your patience would be very much appreciated during the course of the works.

I would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause, but it is my hope that the Bonaly community will greatly benefit from improved safety that the crossing points will deliver.
